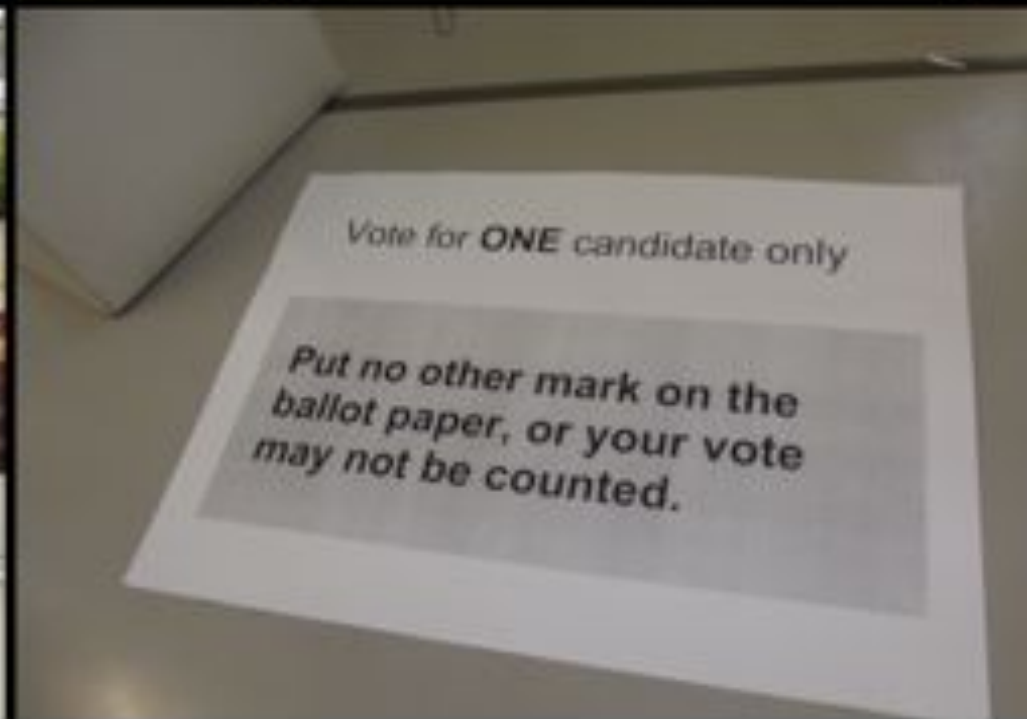

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Our pupils are taught about the Democratic Process in Britain and how by voting we can influence important decisions. We have elections to choose our school council members. Children are encouraged to debate on things that are important to them and to vote on important issues within school.







Pupils are taught to have mutual respect for each other, school staff and visitors. They are encouraged to extend that mutual respect to members of their family, friends and members of their community outside of school.













Pupils in our school are encouraged to accept responsibility for their own decisions and behaviour and to understand that this can have an effect on other pupils. They are encouraged to take pride in their school work and pride in looking after and nurturing their own environment. Pupils are also encouraged to be enterprising and intuitive.













Our pupils learn about the Rule of Law in Great Britain. They learn right from wrong, to obey school rules and to understand and respect that in Britain there are laws which must be obeyed to ensure our safety and wellbeing. We have visits from the local police and pupils take part in role-play, which helps them to understand the rule of law better.









Pupils are taught to have tolerance and respect for those with different cultures, faiths and beliefs. They learn about different religions, lifestyles and cultures. Pupils take part in cultural activities which gives them first hand experience of different cultures.
