

# Religious Education Curriculum

The aim of RE is to engage pupils in systematic enquiry into significant human questions which religion and world views address, so that they can develop the understanding and skills needed to appreciate and appraise varied responses to these questions, as well as develop responses of their own.



## Year 1

### Y1-1:1 Into the Woods

Children will identify objects found in places of worship and discuss peoples beliefs.



### Y1-2:1 London's Burning

Children will discuss how and why do we celebrate special and sacred times. They will identify Christian celebrations and other faith festivals.



### Y1-3:1 Our Wonderful World

Children will discuss what it means to belong to a faith community. They will explore symbols of belonging from their own experiences and faith symbols.



### Y1-1:2 The Land Before Time

Children will discuss who is a Christian and what do they believe? They will retell stories making links between what Christians believe and do.



### Y1-2:2 Once Upon a Time

Children will discuss how and why do we celebrate special and sacred times. They will discuss why celebrations are important to believers.



### Y1-3:2 Out of This World

Children will discuss what it means to belong to a faith community. They will explore how believers express their identity.



## Year 2

Promote respect for self and others.



Develop personal well being and happiness.



### Y2-1:1 There's No Place Like Home

Children will discuss who is a Muslim and what do they believe? They will identify ways Muslims mark Ramadam and celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr.




### Y2-2:1 Where the Dragons Dance

Children will discuss what can we learn from sacred books. They will retell faith stories treating them with respect.



### Y2-3:1 Into the wild

Children will discuss why we should care for others and the world. They will look at stories from different faiths and talk about issues of good, bad, right and wrong arising from the stories.



### Y2-1:2 What the Dickens?

Children will discuss who is Jewish and what do they believe? They will identify ways Jews mark Shabbat and celebrate Hanukah.



### Y2-2:2 Into the Wild

Children will discuss how and why do we celebrate special and sacred times. They will identify similarities and differences between celebrations.



### Y2-2:1 It's a Bug's Life

Children will explore creative ways to express their own ideas about the Creation story and discuss thoughtfully.
