#### Overarching Principles in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

There are four overarching principles in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

#### These are:

- A Unique Child
- Positive Relationships
- Enabling Environments
- Learning and Development

Every child is unique and individual and will make progress at different rates. In order to thrive, learn and develop, they need to have opportunities to create positive relationships with others and explore environments that stimulate their curiosity.

These principles underpin all aspects of teaching and learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage.

# What will my child be learning and doing?

# What will my child be learning and doing?

- In Reception the children will be going outside everyday, regardless of the weather!

# What will my child be learning and doing?

### Playing and Exploring

Children investigate and experience things and 'have a go'.

### **Active Learning**

Children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties and enjoy achievements.

### Creating and Thinking Critically

Children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas and develop strategies for doing things.

### Our Topics and Themes

- We are a 'Quality Texts' school where a wonderful book is selected to be at the heart of our activities and topics.
- We explore the themes through the use of the quality text. We use approaches such as DEAL (Drama Engagement Active Learning) and Tales Toolkit to engage and enthuse the children.

# What will my child be learning and doing?

- A baseline assessment will be carried out at the start of your child's Reception year.
- This is so that we can assess your child's achievements on entry to school.
- Observations of the children will be completed throughout the year by teachers and teaching assistants to assess children's progress and identify next steps on their learning journey.
- We have two Parent's Evenings a year to feedback to you about your child's learning and progress.
- A written report about your child's achievements in Reception will be sent home in July too.

### What will my child need for school each day?

- A waterproof jacket for warmer months and a warm, waterproof coat for the colder months. We will be going outside every day.
- An indoor PE kit (black shorts, white t-shirt and black pumps all named in a named bag). This will stay in school and be sent home during the holidays.
- A spare set of underwear and socks (to be put in the PE bag)
- A school book-bag (available from the School Office). Please name this.
- A water bottle, named.
- Please name all items of school uniform, coat and shoes.
